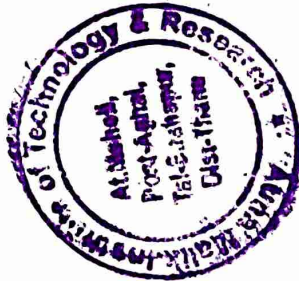
Conclusion
